"In my most recent creations: for ensemble HaP (Festival de Alicante 2010); The Oracle: Tell me a secret in collaboration with the visual artist Gema Álava (Estampa IFEMA Madrid 2011); FANtasy in collaboration with the performer Claire Cunningham (Dansens Hus Stockholm 2011); there is a common element which serves as guiding thread towards the final project I have in my creative horizon. All these works have as main sonic concept and hypothesis: Sounds never disappear, it is us who stop being able to perceive them or they become something else, other types of energy. With proper tools we should be able to hear again all those sounds that surround us constantly.

The element that sets the sounds in vibrating action in *Missa Brevis* is an organ performance that will not change forever the space perception in which the performance happens but the performance itself is altered by all the sonic events that happened before in that particular space. What we hear is not only the sonic history of the performance for it is the last word of a conversation that we started first time we *"heard"*. Maybe, being aware of this sonic-temporal currents will make us more

careful of the legacy we create for future visitors." –Program Notes–
